Eligibility

The fellowship is available to post-doctoral trainees beyond the Ph.D. or M.D.

Award

The fellowship consists of US S 30,000 to 40,000 (depending on experience) to cover all personal living expenses for a duration of 1 year in a chosen laboratory.

A curriculum vitae of no more than two (2) pages which must include applicant's full name, social security number, date of birth, marriage status, residence, phone number, colleges and universities attended, degrees received, post-graduate training, research experience, scholarly awards, publications, and medical experience, if any. All years of education and experience since high school must be accounted for.
- 3. No more than five (5) pages, single-spaced, describing the project proposed by the applicant. The proposal should include:
 - (a) A concise title and an abstract (150 to 200 words) describing the proposed research:

 - (c) A discussion covering the objectives of the work and methods to be employed:
 - (d) A description of general and special facilities and equipment available.
